Teacher: Karla M. Buckley

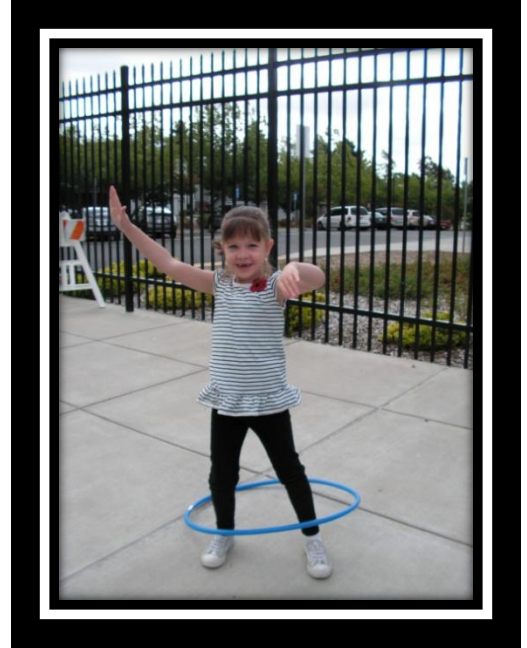
Objective: To create dynamic, personalized audio-visual presentations for students completing the SCOE Transition program.
